

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q) What is the application period for the Entente Cordiale 2023 scholarship programme?
- A) Applications will open on Monday 9th January 2023 and close on Friday 10th March 2023.

Q) Do students need to have already applied to a French institution when submitting their application for an Entente Cordiale scholarship?

A) Yes. Applicants must have ambitious projects in any discipline that will contribute to enhancing the Franco-British relationship and as such are expected to have already established contact with the French university or research public / private institution that will host them. Students will apply for their training programme, mainly, through the Etudes en France platform. For some programmes, students will be redirected to a specific application procedure. They will have to be admitted in their programme before the Entente Cordiale jury meeting takes place.

Q) What kind of mobility is eligible for the Entente Cordiale grant?

Applicants have to be accepted in a training course leading to a Master's level degree. The scholarship can not fund a credit mobility. Besides, online curricula are not eligible. The training programme has to be followed onsite.

Q) What is the duration of the scholarship?

The grant is awarded for a duration of at least 6 months up to one year.

Q) I am a French student looking to study in the United Kingdom. Can I apply for an Entente Cordiale scholarship?

A) No, the Entente Cordiale scholarship is for UK resident, non-French students looking to study in France.

Q) When will the decision be taken if I have been successful in receiving an Entente Cordiale scholarship?

A) The jury will meet in May and all applicants will be informed as soon as possible if they have been successful.

Q) What can the funding from an Entente Cordiale scholarship be used for?

A) The Entente Cordiale funding aims at covering the living expenses of students. Regarding tuitions, fees, students will be waived if they are accepted in a public higher education institution's training programme leading to a national degree (bachelor, master, engineer degree). For other type of training programme, tuition fees will be covered in proportion to the duration of the grant. If the students are admitted in a public institution, tuition fees will be waived. Otherwise, the grant will not cover tuition fees.

Q) How much funding will I receive?

A) Recipients will be entitled to a monthly allowance of €700. Scholarships will not be renewable.
